

## **Shipper's Initial Training Course – CD-ROM**

The cost of the program is \$995 dollars plus \$35 per student and can be used an unlimited number of times. The student takes the course on the CD-ROM and then logs in online to take the exam.

You will need a current copy of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations to accompany the training program. We can supply them at cost -- \$175.00 if you wish.

In each unit there is an overview of the topics to be covered, references to the IATA DGR for appropriate information that the student must read, and then a unit quiz at the end. Students can start and stop the program at any unit and the program will remember where they left off.

The student is allowed two retakes of the IATA exam. After that, the \$35 fee will apply again. (We are doing this to encourage students to really study before just quickly reviewing the program and jumping into the exam).

The duration of the course is 12-18 training hours depending upon the students' familiarity with the regulations.

*Note: this CD is a standalone system – it may not be run off a server and a CD is required at each workstation – it may not be networked. There is no limit to the number of students you can train with a single CD, however, only one person can be logged on at a time.*
